Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Burkett, Contner, Muir and Rudolph present. Absent: Bardole. Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of August 21, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Roger Aegerter, on behalf of the Tower View team, inquired about a finding a location to establish a sculpture park to display the winners of the Bell Tower Festival sculpture contest. The board has indicated that it prefer the Tower View team find another location to display the sculptures after initially exhibiting them on the south courthouse plaza.

Chuck Wenthold reported that the first of the MidAmerican wind towers is partially completed, with the base and midsection erected. Wenthold then reported receiving notice from the IDNR of a construction permit application for two new 2,400-head deep pit hog buildings in Section 25 of Bristol Township by Bruce Youngblood (Youngblood Site). Wenthold has scheduled master matrix scoring review by the board at their meeting on September 11<sup>th</sup> and a public hearing on September 18<sup>th</sup>, both at 9:00 a.m.

Supervisor Dawn Rudolph and Chair John Muir gave a report of a meeting they attended with the Board of Health to continue discussion and possible solutions relating to funding the public health department. Rudolph noted that current services being provided were examined to see whether changes might be considered.

Chair Muir shared written notice received as chair of the assessor's conference board that assessor Linda Spearman plans to retire on November 30, 2017. The examining board will seek out candidates for the assessor position.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve claims for payment. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:05 a.m.
