Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Bardole, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of September 25, 2017. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisors reported on other meetings attended: Mick Burkett reported for a Second Judicial District commission meeting and Peter Bardole reported for Chamber, Airport Commission and Bell Tower Foundation meetings. Dawn Rudolph reported a conference call with mental health region personnel, and John Muir reported on the DD2 informational meeting held in Grand Junction. Environmental health director Chuck Wenthold discussed the status of hiring a coordinator for the North Raccoon Watershed.

Chair Muir reported the Assessor's conference board had met last week to consider an appointment to replace retiring assessor Linda Spearman. Spearman was present in regards to Muir's questions about that process, as was assistant county attorney Thomas Laehn. Discussion included examining board composition and procedures, candidate lists, and timing of the process.

Sharon Stoline and Terry Miller, representing Jefferson's Elderserve (congregate meals) program addressed the board about the decline in federal funds they receive and concerns that there may be a shortage should a large kitchen equipment purchase be needed. Their request for additional funds (unspecified amount) beyond the \$8,000 currently funded by the county was deferred until such time a shortage actually occurs.

Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve a Class C beer permit for Paton Pit Stop. Motion carried unanimously.

Gary Goodwin submitted an estimate for courthouse roof coating for which no action was taken. Don Ihnken thanked supervisor Bardole for his participation in the honor guard at last week's high school football game. Auditor Jane Heun and Recorder Marcia Tasler invited the board to attend an open house at the Dallas County Recorder's office on October 17th to see a demonstration of the office's search site and online index books. The two would like to digitize many of Greene County's real estate and other related records in their offices and have received a proposal from the company that digitized records in Dallas County.

Engineer Wade Weiss presented information from Schumacher Elevator Company on traction elevator modernization for both the courthouse and bell tower elevators. Don Van Gilder gave an update of the planned Courthouse 100 celebration to be held on October 27th.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 10:55 a.m.
