

Special Joint Meeting with Paton-Churdan  
November 29, 2017

A joint meeting of the Greene County and Paton-Churdan Community School Districts' Boards of Education was held November 29, 2017 in the Greene County School Administrative Building in Jefferson. President Mark Peters called the Greene County Board to order at 5:30 p.m. Directors Mike Dennhardt, Steve Fisher, Sam Harding, John McConnell and Catherine Wilson; Superintendent Tim Christensen and Board Secretary Brenda Muir were all present from the Greene County Community School District as were Paton-Churdan Board President Dave Palmer, Directors Mitch Stream, Eric Happe, Dennis Tilly, Sarah Obinna; Superintendent Kreg Lensch, Board Secretary Denise Best and Principal Annie Smith. Greene County Director Steve Karber arrived after roll was called.

Motion was made by Harding seconded by Fisher to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 7-0.

Chris Deal and Sid Jones presented the Regional Academy concept for the Paton-Churdan board. The current sharing of high school classes, sports and staff was reviewed. The boards will continue to meet in sub-committees in June and with a full board meeting in November each year. Greene County President Mark Peters read a letter asking for the Paton-Churdan Board's support of the potential Regional Academy and asking them to consider expanding sharing. Peters would like them to consider sending their high school students to Greene County full time. Superintendent Lensch indicated the Paton-Churdan community is very happy with the current sharing relationship. Superintendent Christensen indicated the Academy classes would be in the morning; therefore, the sharing might look different in the future.

President Peters declared the Greene County board adjourned at 6:42 p.m.
