Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Burkett, Contner, Muir and Rudolph present. Absent: Bardole. Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Rudolph, second by Contner to approve the minutes of January 29, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

Assistant county attorney Thomas Laehn reported twenty-nine new cases in the county attorney's office during January and then shared some general case and trial information with the supervisors. Jefferson mayor Craig Berry requested use of the courthouse square from July 20th to July 24th in conjunction with RAGBRAI's overnight stay in Jefferson on July 23rd of this year. The board agreed to the request.

Joan St Clair of MacDonald Insurance presented insurance information and estimates for the county's next fiscal year budget (FY19). Property & liability contribution estimates to Iowa Community Assurances Pool (ICAP) are estimated to increase by 3% to total \$156,100. The rates remain unchanged, with the increase due to revisions to actual property values. Workers comp contribution through Iowa Municipalities Workers' Compensation Association (IMWCA) is expected to remain nearly the same at \$45,069. Allied bond is estimated at \$2,500 to \$3,000. No action was taken.

Auditor Jane Heun reported an amendment to the current budget will be needed for costs related to repair of the county's ambulance and for a records preservation project down-payment should the board agree to sign a contract for those services. There may be other revenue and expenditures adjustments as well.

General discussion continued until 10:00 a.m., at which time Chair Muir adjourned the meeting.
