Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Bardole, Burkett, Muir and Rudolph present. Absent: Contner. Motion by Bardole, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Bardole to approve the minutes of February 22, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Peter Bardole gave a report of a Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Commission meeting and Supervisor Dawn Rudolph reported on a Central Iowa Community Services meeting. Sheriff Jack Williams informed the board that he is willing to offer an active shooter class to county employees.

During open forum the board heard questions and concerns from Denny Lautner about the upcoming Greene County Schools bond referendum.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Bardole to approve claims for payment. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisors reviewed the master matrix scoring document for Oakview Pork LLC proposed in Section 26 of Greenbrier Township. Nick Miller, Andy Carman and Becky Sexton were present to answer questions about points scored for the construction application. Minimum points required total 440, with this project scoring 450. Points were not taken for landscaping, but a closure plan has been included. The site visit is scheduled later this week, with a hearing planned for March 5<sup>th</sup> at 9:15 a.m.

Scott Weber of Unger Insurance explained a process for a Request for Proposal for another agent to review the county's current ICAP and IMWCA insurance coverage should the board be interested.

Prior to the board's final item, Chair John Muir allowed Mary Figenshaw to address the board about her dismay at the board's decision during its last meeting to commit up to \$5M in funds for construction of a career academy should the school's April 3<sup>rd</sup> bond issue pass.

Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve two satisfaction of mortgage documents for down payment assistance program properties (607 N Chestnut & 808 W Harrison) in Jefferson. Motion carried unanimously.

Muir adjourned the meeting at 10:05 a.m.
