Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Bardole, second by Contner to approve the minutes of March 26, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

Chuck Wenthold reported receiving notice of intent to issue a permit for Oakview Pork, LLC. Thomas Laehn informed the board that the county may charge for employee time when fulfilling public records requests and recommended establishing a policy to reflect that. Rippey resident George Millard addressed the board about an excessive speed problem along P46 as it passes through the town. Millard requested that the board investigate methods of ensuring that vehicles observe the speed limit there particularly for the safety of children playing in that area. Dale Hanaman, representing the local historical society requested assistance from the county with erecting recently purchased signs at various historical markers in the county.

Supervisor Tom Contner reported attending a meeting of the New Opportunities board, and Supervisor Peter Bardole gave reports of three meetings he attended: GCDC executive board, Chamber board, and Bell Tower Foundation board.

Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve auditor signing E911 checks. Motion carried unanimously.

Becky Wolf and Jill Juergensen of Greene County Public Health were present for the board's proclamation for National Infant Immunization Week. Chair John Muir read the document aloud, concluding by proclaiming the week of April 21-28, 2018 as Infant Immunization Awareness Week in Greene County.

At 9:12 a.m., motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to adjourn to a drainage session for those drains included in a Public Drainage System Protection Agreement with MidAmerican Energy Co. for Beaver Creek wind turbine project. Motion carried unanimously. The board returned to regular session at 9:15 a.m.

John Marshall and Scott Cobb of MidAmerican Energy Co., county engineer Wade Weiss, and drainage clerk Michelle Fields were present for the drainage agreement as well as the next agreement under consideration by the board. Motion by Burkett, second by Bardole to approve Road Use & Repair Agreement with MidAmerican Energy Co. for Beaver Creek wind turbine project. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to affirm issuance of 85 construction permits for MidAmerican Energy Co.'s Beaver Creek wind turbine project. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:40 a.m.
