Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve the minutes of May 21, 2018. Motion carried unanimously

Under communications, the board was informed of a probable request for a beer permit for a rural vendor during RAGBRAI. Supervisors voiced their concern regarding allowance of any rural alcoholic beverage permits during RAGBRAI due to limited law enforcement personnel that day.

Chuck Wenthold gave a wind turbine project update. Thomas Laehn reported that the RAGBRAI committee has included the courthouse as a designated emergency shelter on that day. Supervisor Dawn Rudolph reported attending a Central Iowa Community Services meeting. Supervisor Peter Bardole attended Chamber and Bell Tower Foundation meetings.

There was discussion about the county's options for providing ambulance services after July 1st with no decisions made.

At 9:05 a.m. Chair Muir opened a public hearing for a proposed amendment to the county's FY18 budget. After receiving no oral or written comments, motion by Rudolph, second by Contner to close the hearing. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve Resolution 2018-15:

WHEREAS a public hearing has been held for a proposed amendment to the fiscal year 2018 Greene County budget as required by Iowa Code 331.43, and
WHEREAS no written or oral objections have been received on the proposed amendment.
THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Greene County Board of Supervisors adopts said budget amendment, and
BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that the funds for the amended expenditure categories be fully appropriated for the 2018 fiscal year.

Aye: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Resolution carried unanimously.

Additional 2017 Business Property Tax Credit eligible properties (for 2018/2019 taxes) were reviewed with the board by Pam Olerich. Motion by Burkett, second by Bardole to approve the BPTC additions presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve renewal rates for employee Delta Dental coverage for FY19. Motion carried unanimously.

At 9:20 a.m. the board adjourned to three drainage district meetings – DD14 (request for engineer's report), DD18-35 (Joint with Webster Co to consider drainage assessment), DD150-86

(Joint with Carroll Co to consider drainage assessment). Board returned to regular session at 9:35 a.m.

Michelle Fields reviewed a drainage districts assessment schedule with the board. Motion by Rudolph, second by Contner to approve Resolution 2018-16 for drainage assessments:

WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors of Greene County, Iowa, acting as drainage trustees, having investigated the financial condition of Drainage District No. See Attached, and having found from said investigation that the funds on hand and available are insufficient to meet the requirements of said District, and

WHEREAS in the judgment of said Board of Supervisors, an assessment of See Attached % (percent) of the original assessment of benefits in said Districts is necessary to meet the requirements of said Districts, and to pay off outstanding warrants with accrued interest, heretofore issued against said districts.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that an assessment of See Attached % (percent) of the original assessment of benefits heretofore levied in said Districts be, and the same is hereby levied against all of the lands, lots and parcels of ground in said Districts, that said Districts shall bear interest at the rate of six (6) % per annum from and after thirty (30) days from date of assessment which is set for May 29, 2018 and be payable the same as ordinary taxes.
