Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Burkett, Contner, Muir and Rudolph present. Absent: Bardole. Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of June 11, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

Thomas Laehn reported attending the county attorney summer training conference. Laehn believes his office might eventually hire a part-time person for collection of delinquent court obligations at a savings over what is currently being collected by the Boone County attorney's office (for Greene County). Laehn also learned of grants available for hiring a part-time victim/witness coordinator. Supervisor Dawn Rudolph gave a report of attending a Board of Health meeting.

Chair John Muir reported that Steve Linn, representing Backpocket Brewing had contacted him about the board's rejection of a beer permit, agreeing to provide extra security for the event should the board reconsider and approve a permit. Board members present agreed that they do not want to reconsider a permit for the RAGBRAI event.

Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve auditor signing of E911 checks. Motion carried unanimously.

At 8:50 a.m. Chair Muir closed the 2017 Treasurer's Tax Sale and then adjourned the board meeting. The 2018 tax sale by the county treasurer follows at 9:00 a.m.
