Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Bardole, Burkett, Contner and Muir present. Absent: Rudolph. Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Bardole, second by Contner to approve the minutes of August 20, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Tom Contner reported attending a meeting of the Greene County Recycling Agency. Chair John Muir reported that he, assistant county attorney Thomas Laehn, and supervisor Pete Bardole and Greene County School District representatives met related to the county's agreement to issue \$5M in bonds towards the planned career academy. Supervisor Bardole gave reports of several meetings he attended that included city of Jefferson's comprehensive plan update committee, Chamber, Bell Tower Foundation, Airport Commission and Central Iowa Juvenile Detention commission.

Chuck Wenthold reported for a North Raccoon Watershed meeting, provided Greene County unemployment info, and gave a status report on the wind turbines project. Sheriff Jack Williams reported he will soon have a contract with Verizon for a cell tower for the board's consideration at an upcoming meeting. Assistant county attorney Thomas Laehn also provided a brief update to the board.

Ellen Ritter, county mental health service coordinator, has agreed to fill in as the county's general assistance contact in lieu of the departure of Tracie Perez. Ritter was present to acknowledge doing so with the board.

Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve claims for payment. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer Wade Weiss reported to the board prior to adjournment by Muir at 9:20 a.m.
