Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Bardole, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of August 27, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

Chair John Muir reported the newly formed health insurance committee held its first meeting. Billie Hoskins, on behalf of the Greene County 4H Foundation, requested permission to display 4H banners around the inner Square celebrating National 4H week and again the week before and during the Greene County Fair next year. The board agreed to this request. Chuck Wenthold reported Beaver Creek wind tower construction is nearing completion.

The open veteran affairs director position was discussed, with Mick Burkett, supervisor liaison to the Vet Affairs Commission to contact the commission to determine the next steps to be taken.

Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve a 28E agreement with Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center. Motion carried unanimously. The new agreement updates the addition of several member counties.
