

Special Joint Meeting with Paton-Churdan  
October 3, 2018

A joint meeting of the Greene County and Paton-Churdan Community School Districts' Boards of Education was held October 3, 2018 in the Paton-Churdan School, Churdan, Iowa. President Mark Peters called the Greene County Board to order at 7:00 p.m. Directors Steve Fisher, Sam Harding, Steve Karber and Catherine Wilson; Superintendent Tim Christensen and Board Secretary Brenda Muir were all present from the Greene County School District. Directors John McConnell and Mike Dennhardt were absent. Present for the Paton-Churdan School District were Board President Dave Palmer, Directors Mitch Stream, Eric Happe, Dennis Tilly, Sarah Obinna; Superintendent Kreg Lensch, Board Secretary Denise Best and Principal Annie Smith.

Motion was made by Harding seconded by Karber to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

The Paton-Churdan Board President Palmer read a prepared statement to the Greene County Board. They are happy with the sharing arrangement in place. They are not interested in Whole Grade Sharing and would like to negotiate terms of a new agreement.

Both boards will vote on termination of the present sharing agreement at their October regular board meeting. The intent is to have a new agreement ready for board consideration at the December regular board meetings.
