Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of October 15, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Pete Bardole reported attending meetings of the GCDC full and voting boards. Supervisor Dawn Rudolph reported participating by phone in a Decat board meeting. Chair John Muir reported that he and Supervisor Bardole had visited with the hospital regarding continuation of ambulance service in the county potentially through a 28E agreement whereby the county and hospital contribute to an emergency services provider. Further discussion with the local cities is recommended to determine whether each would agree to contribute to ambulance services on a per capita basis.

Chuck Wenthold reported that the Greene County CSD has signed the land agreement required for the urban renewal agreement. Planning & Zoning Commission met and formally agreed that the urban renewal plan coincides with the county's comprehensive plan for county development. Wenthold also reported attending a Beaver Creek Watershed meeting.

Conservation director Dan Towers reported the conservation commission has hired a park ranger for Spring Lake. Joe Allen will begin on November 3<sup>rd</sup>. Towers also informed the supervisors that Lakeside Golf Course has inquired about giving their property to the county for the Conservation department to use alongside Spring Lake Park.

Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve claims for payment and auditor signing E911 checks. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Bardole to approve Resolution 2018-29 for a temporary custodial hire:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Greene County Board of Supervisors approves hiring Linnette Sondgeroth as temporary part time custodian at a rate of \$16/hour effective October 19, 2018.

Motion by Burkett, second by Bardole to approve Resolution 2018-30 to transfer funds to Secondary Roads:

WHEREAS the Greene County Board of Supervisors has set funding transfers in its fiscal 2019 budget,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board, in accordance with Iowa Code §331.432, authorizes transferring \$569,075 from the Rural fund to the Secondary Roads fund as the first one-half of fiscal 2019 Rural funding.

Engineer Wade Weiss reported briefly to the board, after which Chair Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:15 a.m.
