Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Bardole, second by Rudolph to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of November 19, 2018. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Pete Bardole reported attending an Airport Commission meeting. All supervisors participated at the county treasurer recount canvass held last week. Thomas Laehn informed the board that assistant county attorney interviews have been scheduled. Sheriff Jack Williams informed the supervisors that the E911 Service Board met and approved spending nearly \$300,000 for an upgrade necessary to use ISICS (Iowa State Interoperable Communication System) used for public safety communications.

Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve claims for payment and auditor signing E911 checks. Motion carried unanimously.

Dan Clark, Iowa Prison Industries director, was present to review a planned project with Scranton Manufacturing inside the North Central Correctional Facility in Rockwell City. Jim Ober of Scranton Manufacturing and Bob Johnson, correctional facility warden, were also present for the discussion. Scranton Manufacturing will participate in a special program called Prison Industry Enhancement that allows eligible men currently incarcerated at the Rockwell City facility to perform work for the company within the confines of the correctional facility. Benefits to both the company and the offenders were discussed.

Chair John Muir introduced discussion about a new option for employees to choose an HSA for health insurance. The board previously agreed to contribute \$1,000/single and \$2,000/family to those opting for an HSA account in calendar 2019. Muir raised the question as to whether the contribution be made as a lump sum initial deposit or be spread out in some manner over the year. Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to make the \$1,000/single or \$2,000/family contribution in a lump-sum beginning of year contribution for calendar 2019. Aye: Bardole, Burkett, Contner. Nay: Muir, Rudolph. Motion carried.

Engineer Wade Weiss discussed selling a used secondary roads pickup to the city of Scranton. Weiss also reported the county's HVAC project status and discussed putting the project on hold before a final set of drawings is completed (pending determination of funding for the projects).

Muir adjourned the meeting at 10:05 a.m.
