Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve the agenda with the addition of a letter of support to be considered for approval. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Bardole, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of January 28, 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

Conservation director Dan Towers asked that the board support a grant funding request to the Greene County Community Foundation with a letter of support. If awarded, the grant would be used towards the purchase of a concrete latrine for Spring Lake. Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the letter of support as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

County attorney Thomas Laehn noted the Stop the Bleed training (for employees) will be rescheduled. The training was cancelled due to the bitter cold weather conditions. Laehn then discussed moving forward with re-carpeting and painting plans for his office and was given the go ahead to do so.

Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve payment of \$250 to IEMSA for membership. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer Wade Weiss reviewed his proposal for the FY20 Secondary Road budget. Weiss reviewed expenditures for each category and provided info to the board about planned equipment purchases included in the proposal. Weiss included a 3.5% wage increase for secondary road employees. Expenditures are estimated to be just over \$6M, while revenues and transfers from property taxes (general and rural funds) and local option sales tax are estimated at nearly 5.8M. The request includes 3% increases to both general and rural fund property tax-funded transfers which would total \$53,045 and \$1,172,295 respectively. No action was taken by the board.

Supervisor Dawn Rudolph asked that the board look at discretionary funding requests made by outside organizations. While no action was taken, Rudolph asked for review of proposed increases in funding to these organizations before including the requested amounts in the budget.

Muir adjourned the meeting at 10:15 a.m.
