Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with supervisors Bardole, Burkett, Contner and Muir present. Absent: Rudolph. Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of April 8, 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Pete Bardole reported attending meetings of the Chamber, Region XII Policy Council, and GCDC full & voting boards. Chair John Muir reported attending Region XII Executive Board and Policy Council meetings. Chuck Wenthold gave a report of the North Raccoon River Watershed meeting he attended. County attorney Thomas Laehn informed the board he has a good candidate for the assistant county attorney position and hopes to hire soon. Laehn was given informal approval for overnight travel for a conference.

Pete Russell and Doug Rieder were present to update the supervisors with plans for the upcoming 40<sup>th</sup> Bell Tower Festival. Rather than having an enclosed beer garden, plans include opening the courthouse grounds and surrounding streets to participants, similar to the way the past RAGBRAI was handled (beverage wristbands and tickets required). Russell and Rieder shared information about performances and events that will be held as well as the locations for these on or near the Square.

Motion by Burkett, second by Bardole to approve Resolution 2019-15 for funds transfers:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Greene County Board of Supervisors, in accordance with Iowa Code §331.429(1) and §331.432, authorizes the following transfers:

\$569,075 from the Rural fund to the Secondary Roads fund,  
\$162,500 from the LOSST fund to the Secondary Roads fund, and  
\$15,000 from the General fund to the Election Equipment fund

Roll call: Aye: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir. Resolution unanimously approved.

At 9:20 a.m. motion by Contner, second by Burkett to adjourn to a drainage meeting for DD14, tentative approval of Engineer's Report. Motion carried unanimously. The board returned to regular session at 9:30 a.m.

Tanner Stauffer, assistant to engineer, shared a photo showing damage to a bridge piling requiring repair. Motion by Bardole, second by Contner to approve Resolution 2019-16:

WHEREAS the bridge located on a gravel road approximately 0.48 miles North of the West

corner of Section 10 Township 83 North, Range 30 West (Grant Twp) over Hardin Creek is to undergo emergency repairs, and the repair work will make it necessary to close the roadway to vehicular traffic, and;

WHEREAS the Code of Iowa Chapter 306 provides that the Agency having jurisdiction and control over any highway may temporarily close sections of a highway by formal resolution entered upon the minutes of such Agency when reasonably necessary because of construction, reconstruction, maintenance or natural disaster and shall cause to be erected "road closed" signs and partial or total barricades in the roadway at each end of the closed highway section.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Greene County roadway designated as Parkland Avenue be closed to all vehicular traffic beginning at the intersection of 235<sup>th</sup> Street thence North one mile to the intersection with 222<sup>nd</sup> Street located Southwest corner of Section 3, Township 83 North, Range 30 west until repair is completed as determined by the County Engineer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that signs for the road closure be places as directed by the Engineer in accordance with Chapter 306 of the Code of Iowa and all signs remain in place throughout the construction until removed by the directive of the Engineer.
