Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Bardole, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve the minutes of April 22, 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Mick Burkett gave a report of a Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center commission meeting he attended. Chuck Wenthold discussed a press release for a report on Iowa's private wells, issued by the Iowa Environmental Council. Sheriff Jack Williams reported he has interviews scheduled later this week for a deputy sheriff position that will begin July 1st.

Carroll Perkins addressed the board regarding an engineer's report for DD14 and an upcoming informational meeting. Perkins discussed the proposed solution for an area of the district (replacement of tile) and questioned whether open ditch construction might provide better relief than what is proposed. The board encouraged Perkins to share his concerns/questions at the informational meeting scheduled next week.

Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to approve Resolution 2019-18 hiring additional employees for the ambulance department:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors (Board) approves hiring Allison Powell as part-time EMT-B at a rate of \$17/hour, \$4/hour on call; and

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board approves hiring Chad Black as part-time driver at a rate of \$10/hour, \$4/hour on call; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board approves hiring Jason Spencer as full-time EMT-B at a rate of \$38,000/year.
