Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Bardole to approve the minutes of April 29, 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Dawn Rudolph reported participating in interviews for a sheriff's deputy. Sheriff Jack Williams reported his intent to hire Caleb Crowder for that position with June 1st as an estimated starting date. Chuck Wenthold reported that both the Brown and McCormick Sites have received their full construction permits for hog units.

Chair John Muir read a proclamation, signed by the board, making June 2nd "Jerry Roberts Day". Roberts is this year's winner of the IMPACT award, given in recognition for making a difference county-wide through social, educational or cultural contributions.

Mary Weaver and Don Orris were present for the board's review/questions about their grant application for \$5,000 from the county's Dreyfus funds for the construction of a new Animal Shelter/Facility. Orris reported that several individuals have been successful in their grant-writing efforts on behalf of the facility, with funding of approximately \$450,000 of the estimated \$1,134,744 project cost already raised. Orris stated that the plan is to have fundraising completed by next year at this time. The county previously approved an initial agreement to share operating costs totaling \$15,000 per year, effective until June 30, 2022. Motion by Rudolph, second by Bardole to pledge \$5,000 from Dreyfus funds for the Animal Shelter/Facility. Aye: Bardole, Burkett, Muir, Rudolph. Nay: Contner. Motion carried.

Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve the FY20 County Substance Abuse Prevention grant application, with Billie Jo Hoskins also approved as authorized board signatory for the grant program. Motion carried unanimously. The grant fund total is \$1,902.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to accept the Recorder's Report of Fees for April. Motion carried unanimously.

Engineer Wade Weiss discussed the potential purchase of property near the main Jefferson secondary roads facility for additional pipe storage. Weiss was given the board's okay to interview applicants from applications received after the last advertisement for secondary road positions. The department has an open position and one that will be open pending an upcoming retirement.

Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:55 a.m.
