Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Contner, second by Rudolph to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Rudolph to approve the minutes of June 10, 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Pete Bardole reported attending a meeting of the GDCD voting board. County attorney Thomas Laehn reported that the Jefferson city council is to consider a dispatching services agreement whereby the county would receive \$25,000 funding towards those costs next fiscal year. Laehn shared that he has been asked by the sheriff to draft a social host policy (ordinance) to be considered by the board. This pertains to individuals who host or knowingly provide a place for underage persons to drink alcoholic beverages and/or ingest controlled substances.

Drain clerk Michelle Fields reported that she plans to mail out yes/no "ballots" on behalf of Bolton & Menk related to DD14 work to be performed. Fields also discussed DD20 repair work.

Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve a claim for \$5,000 for Dreyfus grant award payable to the Greene County Fair Foundation for south horse barn improvements. Motion carried unanimously. The board informally approved a request for overnight travel from Jane Heun and Billie Hoskins for the auditor summer conference.

Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve a statement of understanding with Central Iowa Community services naming Ellen Ritter as Greene County's service coordinator as .8FTE (full time equivalent) for fiscal year 2019/2020. Motion carried unanimously.

At 8:55 a.m., Chair Muir closed the 2018 Treasurer's Tax Sale. Muir then adjourned the board meeting so that the 2019 Treasurer's Tax Sale might begin in the boardroom at 9:00 a.m.
