Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Bardole, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the minutes of June 27, 2019. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Dawn Rudolph gave a short report of a Decat meeting she attended. Supervisor Pete Bardole reported on meetings attended for the Chamber, Bell Tower Foundation and Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center. County attorney Thomas Laehn shared a draft of a proposed county public art policy for the board member to review and provide input. The policy is scheduled to be considered by the board on July 15th. Engineer Wade Weiss reported on the pavement project near Paton and discussed new banners for the twelve banner poles on the courthouse side of the Square.

Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve Resolution 2019-26, Fingerprinting Policy:

WHEREAS the Greene County Sheriff's Office handles the action of fingerprinting individuals for employment purposes and,

WHEREAS it would be in the best public interest for the Greene County Sheriff's Office to charge a fee for said fingerprints in the amount of \$25 (twenty-five dollars) per set of fingerprints.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Greene County Board of Supervisors, this date met in lawful session, that the Greene County Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to charge a fingerprint fee in the amount of \$25 (twenty-five dollars) per set of fingerprints.
