Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with all supervisors present: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Contner, second by Burkett to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Burkett, second by Bardole to approve the minutes of February 20, 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

Supervisor Dawn Rudolph gave a report of a Decat meeting she attended. Chuck Wenthold reported attending a local Workforce Development meeting.

Motion by Contner, second by Bardole to approve claims for payment. Motion carried unanimously.

County attorney Thomas Laehn reviewed 2020 Addendum to the General Services Agreement between Greene County & Boone County Probation. Addendum document language includes expanding probation services to clients referred by the district and magistrate courts and automatic renewal of the service agreement from year to year. Motion by Rudolph, second by Bardole to approve the 2020 Addendum to the probation services agreement with Boone County Probation. Motion carried unanimously.

At 9:00 a.m., Chair John Muir opened a public hearing to take any comments for the proposed FY21 maximum property tax dollars for both General County and Rural County Services. Hearing no questions or comments, motion by Burkett, second by Bardole to close the hearing. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Bardole, second by Rudolph to approve Resolution 2020-11:

MAXIMUM PROPERTY TAX DOLLARS RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the Greene County Board of Supervisors have considered the proposed FY21 county maximum property tax dollars for both General County Services and Rural County Services; and, WHEREAS a notice concerning the proposed county maximum property tax dollars was published as required and posted on the county website; and,

WHEREAS a public hearing concerning the proposed county maximum property tax dollars was held on February 24, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Greene County that the maximum property tax dollars for General County Services and Rural County Services for FY21 shall not exceed the following:

- General County Services: \$4,485,973, a decrease of .99% (\$45,012) from FY20
- Rural County Services: \$1,766,991, an increase of 1.67% (29,057) from FY20

Roll Call Vote: Aye: Bardole, Burkett, Contner, Rudolph, Muir. Resolution unanimously approved this 24th day of February 2020.

Motion by Burkett, second by Contner to set a public hearing for the Proposed FY21 Greene County budget at 9:00 a.m. on March 9, 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Contner to approve Installation Agreement with SCI Communications, Inc. to install security equipment for the courthouse. Motion approved unanimously.

Angie Gingery, Amy Milligan and Peg Raney were present to share information on Last year's Reunion Rendezvous held during the Bell Tower Festival in June. The event was a "smashing success" per Gingery and the group hopes to expand the hours at this year's festival. Many of those attending class reunions participated in the rendezvous event on the north side of the courthouse. The group shared plans for this year's event and received the board's nod to hold the event in the same location on the grounds.

Muir adjourned the meeting at 9:15 a.m.
