Voters are advised as to the requirements of voter registration in order to be eligible to vote at said election. Friday, May 23, 2014 is the last day to pre-register to vote. This applies to registration in person (also registration at driver's license stations or agencies) or by mail. All voter registration forms must be received by the County Auditor no later than 5:00 p.m. on this day, unless postmarked on or before Monday, May 19, 2014. You may vote an absentee ballot at the County Auditor's office Monday through Friday 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The County Auditor's Office will also be open on Saturday, May 31, 2014 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. for absentee voting.
