Notice is hereby given to the qualified electors of the Greene County Community School District, Greene County, Iowa that a School Election will be held on Tuesday, September 8, 2015. The purpose of the election is to elect two members to the Board of Directors and one member to the Merged Area V Community College District, Director District No. 9. The voters will also be voting on a General Obligation School Bonds question.

The polls will be open from 12:00 noon until 8:00 p.m.

Polling Places are as follows:

Jefferson Precinct, consisting of voters of the school district within the City of Jefferson plus Bristol, Dawson, Franklin, Grant, Greenbrier, Hardin, Jackson and a portion of Section 12 of Willow Township, Greene County will vote in the South Assembly Room of the Courthouse, Jefferson, Iowa.

Scranton Precinct, consisting of voters of the school district within the old Scranton Consolidated School District, more specifically described as: City of Scranton and Scranton Township and parts of Kendrick, Jackson and Willow Townships, Greene County, will vote in the "New" Scranton City Hall, Scranton, Iowa.

Grand Junction Precinct, consisting of voters of the school district within the City of Dana, City of Grand Junction and Dawson, North and South Junction, Paton and Grant Townships, Greene County, and Sections 6 & 7 of Amaqua Township, Boone County will vote at St. Brigid Parish Center, Grand Junction, Iowa.

***Rippey Precinct, consisting of voters within the City of Rippey, Washington and Franklin Townships, Greene County, and Sections 5, 6, 7 & 8 of Union Township, Boone County, will vote at the Rippey Community Center/Public Library.

***Note change in polling place from Rippey Public Methodist Church to Rippey Library/Community Room.
