

WHAT IS PPEL?

- Physical Plant and Equipment Levy (PPEL)
- Voter Approved PPEL must pass through regular election (50%) and will remain in place for up to 10 years
- Maximum taxable amount is \$1.34 per \$1,000 taxable valuation



ALLOWABLE USE OF PPEL

- **-Transportation**: New buses and school vehicles, general maintenance
- -Buildings: Repairs, renovations, expansions, demolition, equipment
- -**Technology**: Audio and visual learning equipment, software, computers




TAXES

Taxes will not increase if approved. Public approval is needed to continue to receive voter-approved PPEL funds for another 10 years. This ensures that GCCSD will have funds for new projects, maintenance, and technology in the future.

- Middle School playground equipment
- Non-instructional software
- Chromebooks and computers for every student
- Touch screen displays in every classroom
- New and updated bus fleet; 2 additional buses
- · Scoreboards in the HS gym and Linduska Field
- · Roof replacement at the Middle School
- Building security updates
- Asbestos removal and demolition at former administration offices
