County Attorney Thomas Laehn reported that there will be a jury trial on May 14, 2024.

During open forum Doug Hawn presented a request for Louis Dreyfus funding for the Greene County Fair Association. Due to increased enrollment numbers in the sheep/goat project area the fair board needs to purchase 46 panels and additional post that will add up to 15 pens in the sheep/goat barns. The fair board plans to have the shop class students at Greene County High School under the direction of Kirk Davis build the panels. Post will be purchased from Hog Slat. Painting of the panels and posts is being arranged between John Deere and Bauer Manufacturing in Paton. The total cost of the project is approximately \$12,000. The fair board is asking for \$5,000 from the Louis Dreyfus fund. The board will consider the funding request at their meeting on May 6, 2024. Hawn also updated the board on the E911 tower project.

Engineer Wade Weiss discussed with the board Bell Tower projects and other secondary roads projects.

Phil Heisterkamp updated the board on activities planned for the 2024 Bell Tower Festival.

Motion by Rudolph, second by Burkett to approve the auditor signing of E911 checks.
