The Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:45 a.m. in the boardroom of the Greene County Courthouse. The following members were present: Bardole, Benitz, Gannon, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Bardole, second by Muir to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Benitz, second by Gannon to approve the minutes of March 30, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

During open forum Ambulance Director Michele Madsen presented her Hospital Transport Report for February. Greene County Medical Center reported thirty-three transports for February. Nine of these were medically necessary to go by other means (flight, secure car, blank peds team). Of the twenty-four remaining twenty were taken by Greene County Ambulance. One was declined by Greene County Ambulance due to no second crew. The remaining three were not utilized because of Greene County Ambulance already on a transfer, VA arranging their own transfer and miscommunication with staff at GCMC.

Supervisors reported on meetings attended. Supervisor Benitz attended a Jail meeting. Supervisor Rudolph attended a Board of Health meeting. Supervisor Bardole attended a Courthouse HVAC meeting.

Motion by Benitz, second by Gannon to set a Public Hearing for the FY27 Budget for April 27, 2026 at 9:00 a.m. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion Bardole, second by Muir to approve the renewal of the buy-down policy for the wind & hail deductible for the New Greene County Jail. Renewal will be from April 15, 2026, to August 24, 2026. If the jail is not complete by this date the county will have to review the policy later in the summer. This is solely for the deductible buy down policy that reduces the wind & hail deductible from a maximum of \$294,000 to \$100,000. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Benitz, second by Bardole to approve the ISAC Dental and Vision rates for July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Muir, second by Gannon to approve Resolution 2026-035 approving the Road Closure of Parkland Avenue (Project No. FM-CO37(85)—55-37).

RESOLUTION 2026-035

WHEREAS, a bridge on a gravel road located on Parkland Avenue between 222nd Street and Greene County Highway E-53 (235th Street) is scheduled to be replaced, and construction work will make it necessary to close the roadway to vehicular traffic, and;

WHEREAS, the Code of Iowa Chapter 306 provides that the agency having jurisdiction and control over any roadway, may temporarily close sections of a roadway by formal resolution entered upon the minutes of such agency when reasonably necessary because of construction, reconstruction, maintenance

or natural disaster and shall cause to be erected “road closed” signs and partial or total barricades in the roadway at each end of the closed roadway section

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Greene County roadway designated as Parkland Avenue be closed to all vehicular traffic beginning at the intersection with 222nd Street thence South one (1) mile to Greene County Highway E-53 (235th Street) until construction is completed as determined by the County Engineer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that signs for the road closure be placed as directed by the engineer in accordance with Chapter 306 of the Code of Iowa and all signs remain in place throughout the construction until removed by directive of the engineer.

Roll Call Vote was taken. Aye: Bardole, Benitz, Gannon, Muir, Rudolph. Resolution unanimously approved.

Motion by Gannon, second by Benitz to approve Resolution 2026-036 approving the Road Closure of X Avenue (Project No. BROS-CO37(92)—8J-37).

RESOLUTION 2026-036

WHEREAS, a bridge on a gravel road located on X Avenue between 200th Street and 210th Street is scheduled to be replaced, and construction work will make it necessary to close the roadway to vehicular traffic, and;

WHEREAS, the Code of Iowa Chapter 306 provides that the agency having jurisdiction and control over any roadway, may temporarily close sections of a roadway by formal resolution entered upon the minutes of such agency when reasonably necessary because of construction, reconstruction, maintenance or natural disaster and shall cause to be erected “road closed” signs and partial or total barricades in the roadway at each end of the closed roadway section.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Greene County roadway designated as X Avenue be closed to all vehicular traffic beginning at the intersection with 200th Street thence South one (1) mile to 210th Street until construction is completed as determined by the County Engineer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that signs for the road closure be placed as directed by the engineer in accordance with Chapter 306 of the Code of Iowa and all signs remain in place throughout the construction until removed by the directive of the engineer.

Roll Call Vote was taken. Aye: Bardole, Benitz, Gannon, Muir, Rudolph. Resolution unanimously approved.

Motion by Muir, second by Bardole to approve Resolution 2026-037 approve Road Closure of Greene County Highways E26 and P46 (Project No. FM-CO38(88)—55-37.

RESOLUTION 2026-037

WHEREAS, a segment of the roadway designated as Greene County Route E-26 located between State Highway 144 and the Boone County line and a segment of the roadway designated as Greene County Route P-46 located between Greene County Route E-26 and State Highway 144 are scheduled for reconstruction, and construction work on this roadway will make it necessary to close the roadway to vehicular traffic, and;

WHEREAS, the Code of Iowa Chapter 306 provides for the temporary closing of sections of roadway, when necessary, because of construction, and that routes closed for construction have a marked and signed detour.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that roadways designated as Greene County routes E-26 and P-46 be closed to all vehicular traffic between State Highway 144 and the Boone County line and between Greene County Route E-26 and State Highway 144, respectively, until construction is completed as determined by the County Engineer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the designated detour for roadway construction on Greene County Routes E-26 and P-46 be located as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Greene County Routes E-18 and P-46 then west three (3) miles to State Highway 144, then south nine (9) miles to State Highway 30, then east seven (7) miles to US Highway 169, then north five (5) miles to Boone County Route E-26.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that signs for the road closure be placed as directed by the engineer in accordance with Chapter 306 of the Code of Iowa and shall signs remain in place throughout the construction until removed by directive of engineer.

Roll Call Vote was taken. Aye: Bardole, Benitz, Gannon, Muir, Rudolph. Resolution unanimously approved.

Motion by Gannon, second by Muir to approve the Iowa DOT FY27 Greene County Secondary Roads Budget and Five-Year Construction Program. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Bardole, second by Gannon to approve Resolution 2026-038 approving the full-time hire of Eric Thompson as IT Director for Greene County.

RESOLUTION 2026-038

BE IT RESOLVED that the Greene County Board of Supervisors approves the hiring of Eric Thompson as full-time IT Director for Greene County. Thompson's early salary will be \$85,000. Effective date of employment is April 13, 2026.

Roll Call Vote was taken. Aye: Bardole, Benitz, Gannon, Muir, Rudolph. Resolution unanimously approved.
