The Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the boardroom of the Greene County Courthouse. The following members were present: Bardole, Gannon, Muir, Rudolph. Absent: Benitz. Motion by Muir, second by Bardole to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Gannon, second by Muir to approve the minutes of April 13, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

County Engineer Wade Weiss reported that he attended a pre-construction meeting for the P46-E26 Construction Project. Construction will begin the week of April 27, 2026. Weiss also reminded the Supervisors that ISAC's 99 County Tour will be here tomorrow morning at 8:30 a.m. in the boardroom of the Greene County Courthouse. All county officials and employees are encouraged to attend.

Environmental Health Director Chuck Wenthold reported to the board that the Rippey Wind Farm and Bedrock Renewables (formally Hardin Hilltop, LLC) met with him last week concerning the process of repowering both farms. He also visited with Alliant Energy concerning the Grand Junction Solar Project.

Supervisors reported on meetings attended. Supervisor Bardole attended the Courthouse HVAC Project meeting.

Motion by Muir, second by Gannon to approve the Sheriff's Quarterly Report of Fees for January, February and March 2026. Motion carried unanimously.
