Motion by Muir, second by Gannon to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Benitz, second by Gannon to approve the minutes of May 26, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

County Attorney Thomas Laehn reported that there will be an Opioid Settlement Committee meeting at 10:00 a.m. to award grants for FY27. He also reported that there will be a jury trial on June 16, 2026.

Environmental Health Coordinator Chuck Wenthold gave a Courthouse HVAC Project update. The old boiler has been removed. Work continues on the roof; completion should be this Friday. Recorder and Clerk of Court should be able to move back to their offices by June 15<sup>th</sup>.
