The Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the courthouse boardroom with the following members present: Bardole, Benitz, Gannon, Muir, Rudolph. Motion by Bardole, second by Benitz to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Muir, second by Gannon to approve the minutes of June 1, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

During Open Forum Ambulance Director Michele Madsen gave her Monthly Ambulance Report for May. Greene County Ambulance transported 21 patients from Greene County Medical Center to other facilities. Four transports were declined by Greene County. Two were due to both of our main ambulances being down because of repair work being done. One of our ambulances did not have the equipment to transport the patients, and one was due to lack of second crew. They also discussed the possibility of ordering a new ambulance now because there is a two-year waiting period. This would give Madsen the capability to start applying for grants. Cost of a new ambulance would be approximately \$356,000.

Philip Heisterkamp gave a final update on road closures due to the Bell Tower Festival.

Supervisors reported on meetings attended. Supervisor Muir participated in a Region XII Development meeting via Zoom. Supervisor Rudolph participated in a CICS meeting and a Decat meeting via Zoom.

City of Jefferson Administrator Scott Peterson gave his monthly update. The Airport Fuel Project will be completed in a few weeks. KCG will hold a grand breaking ceremony this week. He also gave an update on recycling.

Motion by Muir, second by Bardole to amend the minutes of May 26, 2026, to substitute the names of the trustees who voted on Resolution DD2026-001 for the names of their respective counties. Resolution would read as follows: "Roll Call Vote was taken. Aye: Pete Bardole, Dan Benitz, Joe Gannon, John Muir, Scott Longhorn, Erich Kretzinger, Shawn Bryant, Scott Jacobs, Dave George, Gene Meiners, Mike Anderson, Stephanie Hausman, Scott Johnson, Steve Smith, Maggie Armstrong, Brian Johnson, Mike Dickson, JD Kuster, Nathan Montgomery, John Cochran and Austin Hayek. Nays: None. Resolution unanimously approved." Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Bardole, second by Gannon to approve Kristin Lang and Lois J. Miller as Mahanay Maestros for the Mahanay Memorial Carillon Tower. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Bardole, second by Benitz to approve the following change orders:

COR-008 \$1,135.00 Ceiling in Room 107 (Election Room) lowered drop ceiling due to a beam duct work conflict.

COR-009 \$4,926.00 Partial Attic Replacement. This replaces existing lighting on the west side of the attic due to new ductwork and piping blocking the existing lights.

COR-011 \$5,073.00 Cooling in closet #127 – This adds cooling to the room where the outside sound system main computer is located.

COR-014 \$1,059.00 Adds receptacles in Pumps 405 for the glycol feeder and to have a convenience receptacle in the room.

COR-015 \$901.00 Fire Damper in 112 County Engineers Office. Adds a fire damper to an existing floor penetration that was hidden by furniture.

COR-016 \$3,467.00 Clerk 206 and RR206B Ceiling and Mechanical Modifications – This adds a bulkhead to Clerk 206 due to the lower ceiling height in RR206B and a bulkhead at the stair due to the existing bulkhead being constructed of drop ceiling material.

Motion carried unanimously.

At 9:11 a.m. motion by Benitz, second by Gannon to adjourn to a drainage meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

At 9:13 a.m. motion by Bardole, second by Benitz to return to their regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Muir, second by Gannon to approve claims payable for June 8, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

Bardole adjourned the meeting at 9:14 a.m.
