The Greene County Board of Supervisors met at 8:30 a.m. in the boardroom of the Greene County Courthouse. The following members were present: Bardole, Benitz, Gannon, Muir, Rudolph. There was no Zoom access for today's meeting due to technical issues. Motion by Muir, second by Gannon to approve the agenda. Motion carried unanimously. Motion by Benitz, second by Bardole to approve the minutes from July 6, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

County Attorney Thomas Laehn reported that he is reviewing several 28E Agreements and will have them ready for the Board's approval in the coming weeks.

Supervisors reported on meetings attended. Supervisor Muir attended a Region XII Policy Council meeting. Supervisor Bardole attended an HVAC meeting and a GCDC Executive Board meeting.

County Engineer Wade Weiss reported that pavement crushing will begin on P46 today. He reported on gravel stockpiles and discussed the purchasing of two maintainers over the next two fiscal years.

Informal overnight travel was approved for Weiss to attend the NACO Conference in New Orleans, Louisiana.

City Administrator Scott Peterson gave his monthly report for the City of Jefferson. Bids for the Westwood Drive Sidewalk Project have been received. The bids will be considered at the July 14, 2026, Council meeting. Fuel Farm Project at the airport is complete. Crews are working on DD#57 to remove tree roots. City Council will be working on regulations concerning Electric Bikes and Electric Scooters.

Motion by Bardole, second by Muir to approve the Sheriff's Quarterly Report of Fees for April, May and June of 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Gannon, second by Muir to approve the two-year service agreement with Howard E. Nyhart Company, Inc. (Nyhart) for actuarial services related to GASB75 post-employment benefits for FY27 and FY28. Motion carried unanimously.

At 8:57 a.m. motion by Bardole, second by Benitz to adjourn to a drainage meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

At 9:00 a.m. motion by Benitz, second by Gannon to return to their regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Muir, second by Bardole to approve claims for payment for July 13, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.
